

## VBC CHILD CARE CENTER

### Fee Overview

#### 1. Definition of Roles: Wiener Kinderfreunde („Kinderfreunde“) | Vienna BioCenter Core Facilities („VBCF“)

Kinderfreunde provides the childcare services and personnel. Kinderfreunde bears all legal responsibility running the child care center and complying with the applicable laws.

VBCF is the founder and sponsor of the Child Care Center. VBCF bears the financial risk for the operation and thus invests its core funding to support our childcare center.

#### 2. Financing sources of the Child Care Center (CCC)

The CCC is being financed through four sources:

- Funding by the City of Vienna (Magistratsabteilung MA 10) to Kinderfreunde
  - basic childcare fee (from 154,76 to 356,17 depending on the age of the child)
  - childcare fee for Vienna residents of 268,55€ per month \*
- Monthly Fees paid by the Parents to Kinderfreunde (see 3.1.)
- Company Contribution paid to VBCF (see 3.2.)
- VBCF Core Funding, covering the remainder of costs

#### 3. Fee/Contribution composition

##### 3.1. Monthly Fees paid by the Parents to Kinderfreunde

As mentioned above, the monthly costs include expenses which are paid to the Kinderfreunde. The prices are set according to age and the program envisaged for each age group. The prices are adjusted annually. The following table shows gross prices as of September 2021:

(\* The total fees refer to Vienna residents only. Should the family change their registered address (“Meldeadresse”) outside the municipality of Vienna, the support for Vienna residents is no longer applicable. The monthly fee then increases by 268,55€.

Other expenses (non-recurring) include the inscription fee (80,00 €) and the general deposit (80,00 €), only in MQM additional deposit for the Chipcard (35,00 €). The deposit is paid back once the child leaves the CCC.

### 3.2. Company Contribution paid to VBCF

The Company Contribution is paid to VBCF on a quarterly basis. Along with the VBCF core funding, this contribution is used for financing the CCC (see 2.). If the company contribution is not covered by the employer, the parents have to pay these fees as private persons (gross, incl. 20% VAT).

## 4. Cases

### 4.1. Company contribution paid by the employer

4.1.1. At least one parent is an employee of a VBC / MQM institute or company, and the employer agrees to take over the quarterly costs. Monthly costs for the family include the contribution to Kinderfreunde, according to the table in 3.1, whereas the employer covers the costs in 3.2.

4.1.2. The parents are employed by two different institutes/companies, they must clarify with their respective employers if the company contribution (3.2.) will be split or covered by one employer entirely.

### 4.2. Company contribution not paid by the employer

One or both parents are working at VBC / MQM, but their employers do not cover the company contribution. The parents sign an agreement for taking over the company contribution as private persons. In addition to the monthly fees (see 3.1.), the parents have to pay the company contribution as well (see 3.2.).

### 4.3. Relocation

If the Family moves from Vienna to Lower Austria, they lose the funding for Vienna residents (see 3.1.). An additional fee of 268,55 has to be paid.

### 4.4. Employment contract expires

If the parents/one of the parents are/is no longer employed at the VBC / MQM, they must take over the Company Contribution, that used to be paid by their employer, as an additional fee (see 3.2.).
